APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The applicant must be enrolled in an approved institution of higher education, current status freshman, sophomore or junior, obtaining their Bachelor's or Master's degree. (Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, materials, housing and other unmet student needs.)
- 2. The applicant must be enrolled in a building industry-related curriculum.
- 3. The applicant has achieved a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 4. The applicant must be a California resident with an objective of a future career within the *California* homebuilding industry.
- 5. Hall of Fame scholarships are awarded in person at the California Homebuilding Foundation's Hall of Fame awards dinner on May 23, 2023, at The Westin Anaheim Resort, Anaheim, CA. *Attendance is mandatory.* Hall of Fame is the homebuilding industry's most iconic celebration. Scholarship recipients are permitted to bring one (1) guest.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants are evaluated on the following criteria:

- 1. Financial need
- 2. Career goals
- 3. Academic achievement
- 4. Extracurricular activities
- 5. Work experience, including internships
- 6. Recommendations

OBLIGATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- 1. To enroll and maintain a satisfactory GPA of 3.0 or higher at an approved college or university during the academic year in which they received this scholarship.
- 2. To pursue a course of study that will qualify the applicant for a professional career in the *California* homebuilding industry.
- 3. To conduct oneself in a manner that exemplifies good character.
- 4. To report to the California Homebuilding Foundation annually of academic progress or employment status upon graduation by responding to any administered surveys or requests for interviews or testimonials.

APPLICATION PROCESS (All items must be included with application submission)

- 1. Complete and return the attached application.
- 2. Applicant must submit a brief statement about themselves, including their educational and career intentions.
- 3. Applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from adults: one teacher or professor within the last two years and an adult from work-related experience (other than a relative) who can offer professional references for the applicant.
- 4. Applicant's college transcript must accompany application.
- 5. Applications must include a suitable self-portrait in a JPG or TIFF format at 300 DPI resolution or above. Submit photo as a separate attachment.

AWARD INFORMATION

- 1. Students can expect to receive \$5,000 to \$10,000 per award.
- 2. Applications will be reviewed and finalists selected by the California Homebuilding Foundation Scholarship Committee.
- 3. Scholarship checks are payable to recipients college and mailed directly to the institution unless otherwise specified.
